



Remissions/Exclusions Policy Statement

Whilst exclusion is always to be regarded as a strategy of last resort, the Principal is entitled to exclude a pupil/student from school if there is a foreseeable risk of the pupil/student endangering himself/herself or other pupils or staff or, in some cases property. When possible, twelve hours notice will be given to the parents and the Local Authority.

If a pupil/student does not appear to be benefiting from attendance at the school, the school authorities will ideally give at least nine weeks notice to the parents and the Local Authority that the school is no longer meeting the child's needs and that alternative arrangements may need to be considered. However, the Annual Review process will remain the usual mechanism for identifying and ensuring appropriate provision.
